 <b>Edmodo</b>	<b>FREE</b>	An online learning program where students can extend their thinking and learning.
 <b>Calculator</b>	<b>FREE</b>	This app allows your child to access a free calculator.
 <b>Dictionary</b>	<b>FREE</b>	This is an offline dictionary that your child will not need access to the internet for.
 <b>Show Me</b>	<b>FREE</b>	ShowMe is a free app which will allow students to narrate the work they have done on a whiteboard.
 <b>iMovie</b>	<b>FREE</b>	iMovie allows students to create movies and trailers using footage shot from their iPad.
 <b>Prezi</b>	<b>FREE</b>	A more advanced, free version of Microsoft PowerPoint.
